- All members must play within the rules and respect officials and their decisions.
- All members must respect opponents.

- Members must wear suitable kit (white t-shirt or cricket shirt, white cricket trousers and training shoes for matches, tracksuit bottoms or shorts can be substituted for cricket trousers for training) for training and match sessions, as agreed with the coach/team manager.

- Junior members are not allowed to smoke on club premises or whilst representing the club at competitions.
- Junior members are not allowed to consume alcohol or drugs of any kind on the club premises or whilst representing the club.
